Rural VFD Assistance Program (HB 2604)

New Grant Category - Volunteer Recruitment Resources

As of **February 1st, 2023**, a new grant category will be available through the Rural VFD Assistance Program. The Volunteer Recruitment Resources category is being added as a pilot project, aiming to help volunteer fire departments bolster staffing and enhance community fire protection.

This category is provided by Volunteer Fire Assistance (Federal) Funds, and therefore is available exclusively to departments that meet **all** of the following federal eligibility requirements:

- Department must serve a rural area or rural community with a population of 10,000 or less
- Certified by Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) as having adopted NIMS
- Department must not be debarred, suspended, or declared ineligible by any federal department or agency*
- 80% or more of department personnel must be volunteers

**Upon award, grant recipients will receive an AD-1048 Certification Letter that must be completed and returned for final grant approval*

Cost-Share Rate:

100% of the actual cost, not to exceed **\$3,000** per department
